- Continue to reduce the Linenhall Arts Centre's resource consumption, pollution and Co2 emissions.
- Continue to reduce the Linenhall Arts Centre's wastage; especially landfill.
- Actively promote recycling amongst artists, customers, staff and suppliers.
- Integrate the consideration of environmental concerns and impacts into all decision making and activities
- The Linenhall Arts Centre is committed to prioritising environmental matters by monitoring and improving our work in this area.
- Programme more events with an environmental theme.

By 2025 we will:

Reduce consumption by installing new LED lighting and heating systems throughout the building

Reduce pollution by examining our cleaning products and source more environmentally friendly and less toxic products

Reduce water consumption with new motion sensor taps in all bathrooms

Reduce consumption by installing thermostats and monitoring heating at a consistent temperature

Reduce waste by reducing stock purchases for our coffee shop as required and eradicating food waste

Reduce waste by banning single use plastic bottles, encourage staff, artists and audiences to use reusable water bottles

Reduce our Carbon Footprint by reviewing our printing requirements and using more environmentally friendly printers

Increase awareness through our social media channels and website to encourage public engagement around environmental issues

Increase awareness amongst all staff around environmental issues

Reduce consumption by moving to a ticketless box office system

Reduce usage by encourage default power saving settings on all devices
